From The Current Bylaws

Article V
Meetings

Section 1. Executive Council. The ACCA Executive Council shall meet at least once each year. A meeting of the ACCA Executive Council shall be held at the time and place of each National Convention of ACA. Additional meetings of the Executive Council will be held as deemed necessary by the Executive Council, the President, or the Executive Committee. At least one-half of the members of the ACCA Executive Council shall constitute a quorum throughout any meeting of the ACCA Executive Council at which official business is transacted. Between meetings of the Executive Council, the Executive Committee shall be empowered to conduct the business of the Association. A majority of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum for that body.

Section 2. Membership. An annual meeting of the ACCA membership shall be held yearly at the ACA Convention or the ACCA Conference for the purpose of hearing summary reports from officers and committees and conducting such business of the Association as deemed necessary by the Executive Council.

Proposed Change to the By Laws

This Proposed Change to the By Laws allows the ACCA Executive Council meeting and the meeting of the membership to be held at either the ACCA National conference or at ACA.

Article V
Meetings

Section 1. Executive Council. The ACCA Executive Council shall meet at least once each year. Additional meetings of the Executive Council will be held as deemed necessary by the Executive Council, the President, or the Executive Committee. Between meetings of the Executive Council, the Executive Committee shall be empowered to conduct the business of the Association. A majority of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum for that body.

Section 2. Membership. The ACCA membership shall meet at least once each year at the time and place of each National Conference of the ACCA and/or ACA National Convention for the purpose of hearing summary reports from officers and committees and conducting such business of the Association as deemed necessary by the Executive Council.
